Right of Way (RoW) easements have been provided "At Risk" prior to the City of Chino prior to FAA approval. Outside Counsel has been engaged to prepare the County's position on Federally obligated property conveyance to the City for RoW easements/property rights for street improvements.

Kimball Avenue Stormwater Conveyance. There is an existing and amended MOU with the City of Chino. The conveyance will allow water to traverse from the Airports north stormwater basin to the south basin on the other side of Kimball Avenue.

Kimball Avenue Widening. The County is coordinating with the city for the street widening of one westbound lane on a portion of Kimball Avenue.
